



- Angel comes from a family of three, children of a single mother who is mentally disturbed. The children were taken care of by their aged grandmother, and when they heard about Zion, they came to ask for help. Now she is doing great and happy to be in Zion family.
- Tonny comes from a family of three children who had lived happily with their parents until 2016 when their father came from work one evening and without a quarrel took a machete and cut their mother severely, leaving her dead, and fled. The grandmother, who has no income, heard about Zion Home for Children and we agreed to admit Tonny, who is now doing great.
- Emmanuel comes from a family of 6 children, whose mother had nothing to feed them after the death of her husband. She felt so overwhelmed to care for them, 4 of which were supposed to be in school but were not, that she ran away, leaving the children at the mercies of the area chief and the neighbors. Officials referred the 4 vulnerable children to Zion, leaving the 2 older ones at home to fend for themselves.

**Centers Of Hope Mission International** (Project 7220011-035 of The Church of God World Missions) has partnered with Manifest Christ Ministry of Mutomo, Kenya to operate Zion Home for Children to raise destitute children of the area "in the instruction and discipline of the Lord".

Currently there are 110 resident children who are provided with everything needed for life and godliness: Food, clothing, shelter, schooling, medical care, Bible teaching and memorization, prayers, and godly examples. The project is directed by Pastor Harrison Kimwele and wife Alice who also lead the church meeting in the orphanage building. It has grown in three years from 7 to 250 in weekly attendance. Pastor Harrison grew up in extreme poverty and lived in the slums of Nairobi before meeting Christ and graduating from Bible school. He and Alice also took in his nieces and nephew who were orphaned themselves, so they have a great heart of compassion for the needy in their community.



Children of Zion

These children are cared for only through the donations of faithful sponsors with monthly support of \$60. This is the full cost (except for housing which was funded through other donations), only \$2 per day! Because Centers of Hope is a completely voluntary organization, **100% of gifts is sent to Zion** – there is nothing taken for overhead, administrative costs, travel, or fundraising.

Each child has only one sponsor, and he writes that sponsor a personal letter in English every two weeks. Sponsors in turn are encouraged (but not required) to write back so that a loving relationship can develop. Part of the transformation of the child's life is knowing that there is someone in America who loves him. It is each child's fervent prayer to have his own American family, but currently only about one third have seen their hopes and prayers answered. Nevertheless, all the children are very happy to have their own bed, go to school with adequate supplies, learn to worship God, and receive 3 good meals daily. **You can make a child's joy complete!**
